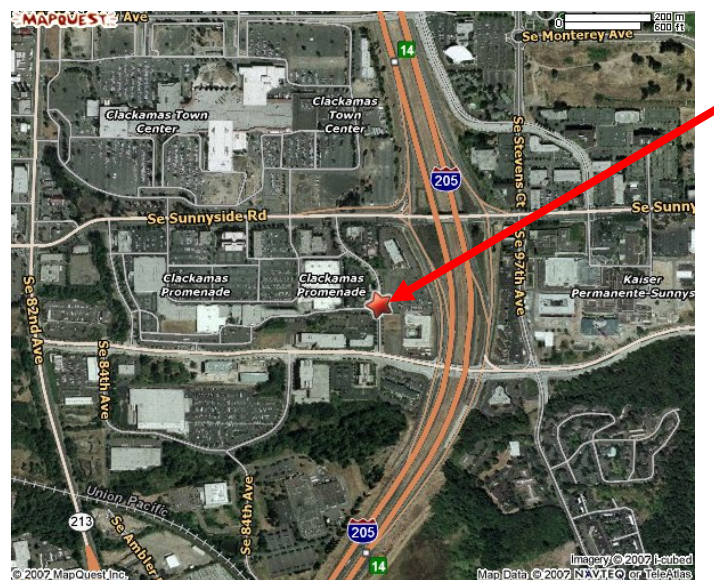
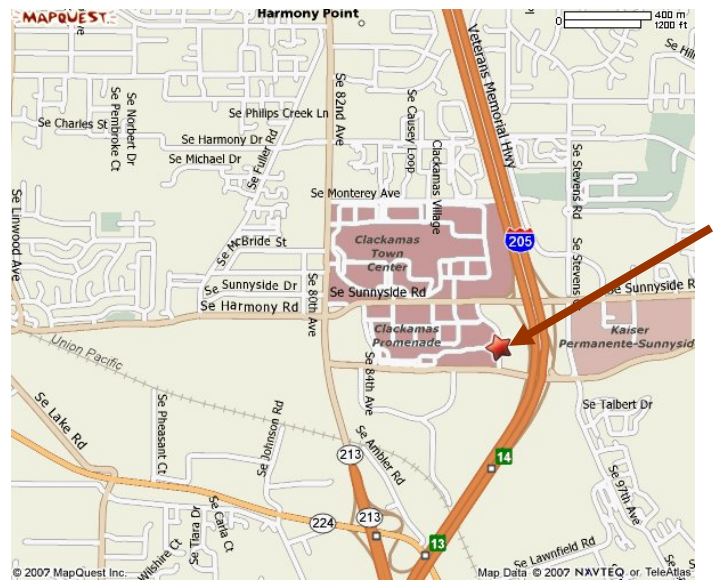
Special dietary considerations can be honored—just let us know.
